He was elected Vice President of the FWD Northern California Division, became a FWD Contest and Judging Secretary, a member of the International COTS Faculty, General Chairman of four FWD conventions, and was elected FWD President in 1988 and 1989 and International Board Member in 1992 and 1992.

Over the years, Chuck became an exclusive member of the International Man of Note Club, sponsoring 64 new members into our Society, became a member of the International Restructuring Committee and the International Nominating Committee.

Chuck, whose vocabulary does not include the word "NO," responded to a call from our overseas brethren to serve as Dean of the New Zealand/Australian Harmony College and Chairman of the Judging Panel of the NZABS National Convention. He went on to organize and serve as Host Chairman for the visitation of the BABS Bristol Chorus immediately following the Salt Lake City International Convention.

Chuck recognizes that singing in a quartet is what barbershopping is all about, having sung in *The Blenders*, *Our Gang*, *Added Attraction*, *Sing, Sing, Sing*, *On the Road Again*, and *On the Town*.
