Still to come are the results of the FWD quartets that have chosen to compete out of District: **Metropolis** and **Audacity**.

In FWD's fifth year at Reno which included the combination Spring Prelim-NorCal East Divisional, 24 quartets trod the boards with some opting for the Prelims, some for the Divisional and some for both.

The top NorCal East Quartet and qualifying for the Fall district contest was **Tahoe Blue** (Reno).

Fresno's Gold Note Chorus took the top honors in the NorCalEast NoNev Divisional with Reno's Silver Dollar Chorus second place by a mere 6 points. Central California's Golden Valley Chorus was third; all qualified for the district Fall contest

The High School Quartet Contest, which was judged by **OC Times** and **Late Show**, found six good-sounding young quartets vying for the crown. **The Chromatones** (Napa High School) took the gold with **BOGG** (Ponderosa High School Shingle Springs) the silver, and , **CAP'D** (Carson High School, Carson City) , **The Harmonics** (Lincoln High School, Stockton) **The Good Ones**, and the **Blond Bombshells** (both from Fullerton High School, Fullerton), close behind.

CONVENTION AWARDS

The convention was dedicated to long-time (over 53 years) Society member and Stockton Chapter member, **Bill Legg.**

Dave Briner was inducted into the prestigious **FWD Hall Of Fame** by **Jim Sherman** and the near-dozen current members of HOF who were in attendance.

Conejo Valley was named "*Chapter Of The Year*," as a result of their fine efforts in behalf of Barbershopping as a whole demonstrating leadership within FWD

The Charter for the **Laguna Hills Chapter** was presented to Secretary Dick Girvin for transmittal to the chapter.

Delegates and officers attending the Spring meeting of the FWD House of Delegates were treated to an inside look at the Society's upcoming plans for the move to Nashville as presented by Society representative (and FWD IPP) **Peter Feeney.**

Other important issues were presented to the assembled delegates and included:

- FWD Bulletin Editor of the Year (Large Bulletins) Alan Swanson, Sacramento Tags & Swipes
- FWD Bulletin Editor of the Year (Small Bulletins) **Bruce Smith,** Hemet, *Upbeat*.
