## 2011 FWD SoCal High School Quartet Contest

Information for Quartets, Parents, Chaperones, and Music Educators

The PRE-CONTEST briefing will be in the Band Room around 2:00PM on SATURDAY.

#### Hello!

Welcome to the wonderful world of barbershop harmony! Thank you for registering your quartet for the SoCal High School Quartet Contest (HSQC), sponsored by the Far Western District (<a href="http://bhsfwd.org/">http://bhsfwd.org/</a>) of the Barbershop Harmony Society (<a href="http://www.barbershop.org/">http://www.barbershop.org/</a>). This should be an exciting contest.

When and Where: The SoCal HSQC is being held in conjunction with our barbershop Southwest Division Convention on Saturday, May 7, 2011. The contests are being held at the Duarte Performing Arts Center, 1401 Highland Ave., Duarte, CA (near Pasadena). See the appended maps and layouts.

The Schedule: High school quartets can check in after 9 AM to get the latest information. Gather in the HSQC briefing room (Band Room) at 2 PM for instructions and learning a "tag" to sing as a group. This is a chance for any quartets or parents to get their questions answered, so we will always allow time for that. The HSQ contest is scheduled to begin around 4:00 PM, but could start earlier. Currently, there are five quartets indicating interest. The judges' coaching sessions follow the contest, and all parents and Music Educators are encouraged to sit in on these sessions.

Contest events start Saturday morning with our Men's Choruses at 10 AM. After a break for lunch, we'll see the men's quartets compete to qualify to go to the District-level convention in the Fall. This will be followed by the HSQC. You are welcome and encouraged to attend these until Intermission at around 2 PM, when you assemble in the Band Room. We'll also get to hear the winning chorus and men's quartet, and the high school quartet champs, in a short show following the announcement of awards. Although the choice of what to perform is up to them, most often the quartets will repeat one of the songs from the competition, since those two songs have been rehearsed to a high level and are ready for performance. This is perfectly acceptable. Do not feel that you need to have a third song prepared for this, but you are welcome to sing another in your repertoire. It need not be a contestable barbershop song.

Our high school youths will then retire to the HSQC briefing room to have their performance reviewed for learning purposes. We should be done with everything by about 6-6:30 PM. This will be followed by an "afterglow" pizza party at a local restaurant. Many of the men's quartet contestants will drop in and sing, and so can you.

The Costs: All competing quartet members in the high school quartet contest are getting registration packages at no cost to them, compliments of the FWD. That means they get to attend ALL of these events FREE. Please note that you and any other family or friends can attend for the reduced rate of FREE to cheer the boys on. Special name badges will be issued if you give me the names of the guests expected to arrive. You can obtain these on site when you arrive.

Courtesy and Distractions: Remember to be completely silent during the actual performance of any contest song by a quartet. But, banners, signs, pom-poms, and cheering sections are all encouraged as groups are introduced (just no noisemakers or air horns, please). If younger brothers or sisters find it difficult to remain quiet through the contests, sometimes they may need to wait out in the lobby. No one will be allowed to enter or leave the auditorium during a performance to prevent distraction from people moving and the light of opening doors.

Flash photography is a no-no, and video or audio taping of any barbershop contest, except by authorized agents, is prohibited due to copyright regulations. To help preserve the experience for the guys, we've arranged for each quartet to be video recorded. Each quartet will receive a DVD video and audio CD of their contest performance.






